

Stuart Presbyterian Church believes that marriage is a union between one man and one woman, ordained of God and intended to last as long as the couple shall live. We find this belief firmly rooted in the Scriptures of the Old and New Testament. For example,

²⁴For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be united to his wife, and they will become one flesh.

Genesis 2:24 (NIV)

*⁶But at the beginning of creation God made them male and female.
⁷For his reason a man will leave his father and mother and be united to his wife, ⁸and the two will become one flesh. So they are no longer two, but one. ⁹Therefore what God has joined together, let man not separate.*

Mark 10:6-9 (NIV)
