  - He teaches us (Jn.14:26); helps us (Jn. 14:16-17; 14:26; 15:26; 16:7) and guides us (Jn. 16:13).
  
- Fellowship with the Holy Spirit (2 Cor. 13:14).

(Acts 5:3-4)
  
- 2. Holy Spirit is Omniscient (1 Cor. 2:10-11)**

“The Holy Spirit, the third person of the Trinity, proceeding from the Father and the Son, of the same substance and equal in power and glory, ....”
